The regional service also provides care to patients from all regions of the LHIN and plays an essential role in the support of other regional programs including stroke prevention and regional renal dialysis program.

The successful candidate will be expected to demonstrate experience and training in contemporary management of vascular disease appropriate for a vascular referral centre. The successful applicant's clinical skill set must include facility with surgical, endovascular (both aortic and peripheral), and hybrid interventions for arterial and venous disease. He/She will be expected to show evidence of interpersonal and collaborative skills and initiative to further advance the clinical and academic productivity of the regional vascular service.

Applicants must have a Fellowship in Vascular Surgery, certification from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada and be eligible for licensure in the Province of Ontario.
