

# Vascular Surgeon

## Department of Surgery, Division of Vascular Surgery

At Scarborough and Rouge Hospital (SRH), the patient experience comes first. With three hospital sites (Birchmount, General, and Centenary) and five satellite sites, SRH provides a broad spectrum of health services to one of the most diverse communities in Canada. Created through a merger of The Scarborough Hospital's Birchmount and General sites and Rouge Valley Health System's Centenary site in December 2016, SRH is committed to delivering the highest quality patient- and family-centred care, with a focus on enhancing access to services for the Scarborough community.

Patient services include a full-service Emergency department at each site, advanced maternal and neonatal care in state-of-the-art birthing centres, and specialized paediatric care. In addition, SRH is home to a number of regional programs serving the central east Greater Toronto Area and beyond, including cardiac care, nephrology, vascular surgery, and vision care, and is recognized as a centre of excellence in orthopaedic surgery, cancer care, and mental health.

SRH is the regional dialysis centre, with the largest hemodialysis program in Ontario. It is also the regional vascular center serving as the referral center for the Central East LHIN. SRH serves as the regional CritiCall referral center for the western Central East LHIN and portions of the Central LHIN as well.

The Department of Surgery, Division of Vascular Surgery, at the Scarborough and Rouge Hospital is seeking a Vascular Surgeon to join a team of dedicated vascular surgeons and interventional radiologists. The successful candidate will be working with a strong, supportive and collegial group of colleagues in a three-site community hospital organization committed to providing high quality, comprehensive clinical services. As SRH is affiliated with the University of Toronto, the successful candidate will be expected to participate in the teaching of Vascular Fellows

Candidates must have experience in diagnosis and treatment of the full spectrum of vascular disease. This includes: open and EVAR repair of aortic aneurysms, carotid disease, dialysis access creation, pacemaker implant, peripheral bypass and angioplasty as well as venous disease. Candidates must have excellent communication and interpersonal skills and be willing to work within interdisciplinary teams, including advanced wound care nurses. Experience with treatment of diabetic ulcers is preferable. Experience in Quality Improvement is also an asset.

The successful candidate must be registered or eligible for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario, and have successfully completed a fellowship in Vascular Surgery with the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada.
